- 1. Vacancy Report Ms. Skoda advised a couple of meetings ago there was discussion on how the Board would know if there are vacancies. - L. Clinical Health/Medical Director's Report
 - 1. Communicable Disease Report (See Enclosure.) Dr. Sobolewski reported last week there was a Health Advisory Alert for H5N1 (Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza.) It was noted the first person in the United States since 2022. There's been a total of two people since there was tracking. FDA is monitoring weekly and updating how many cows. Texas is the source. There were 20 positive dairy cattle: Texas (9), Kansas (3), Michigan (2), New Mexico (4), Idaho (1), Ohio (1.) The cattle in Ohio were purchased from Texas. There have been 23 countries with human cases since 1997 ranging around 900 cases. Fifty percent mortality in those cases. The two human cases in the United States have been fairly minor. The Ohio case is a farmhand with conjunctivitis. They were able to treat him with an antiviral and prophylaxed the household contacts as well and everyone did just fine. They did sequencing on the person as well has the cattle. The viral sequencing is very similar. Thankfully, CDC does have a vaccine with that viral sequencing and shouldn't become a bigger issue. The number of wild birds and poultry are astronomical. In Ohio, there are nine million birds with bird flu. The mortality in the bird population is 100%. It does spread in dairy milk. Pasteurization does kill it. Stay away from dead birds and pets that interact with dead birds.
